



Quality Assurance Management Professional QAMP

Certificate

Since the beginning of 2008, the personnel certificate QAMP® (Quality Assurance Management Professional), a new certificate for advanced vocational training of software engineers, has successfully been introduced in cooperation with and according to the needs of the IT-industry. It is directed towards quality assurance managers, because they require competence in the entire development process. In addition to a broad theoretical knowledge – which needs to be demonstrated by 3 successfully passed certification examinations – it attests the practical knowledge and project experience of the certified employee. Theoretical and practical knowledge both have to be updated biannually.

Upon completion of all three certificates and proof of the two year practical experience, the participant will be certified as **iSQI Quality Assurance Management Professional (QAMP)**.

The QAMP certificate is **valid for 24 month after the date of issue**.

To extend the validity of the certificate for a further period of two years (Re-Certification) practical work experience must be demonstrated by the applicant and recognized by iSQI.

- or another certificate in the field of software quality assurance management
- or a lecture given at an international conference, e.g. CONQUEST, SiGIST, STAREAST, STARWEST, SQC, SWISS TESTING DAY, SEETEST, EUROSTAR, TESTING & FINANCE, others on inquiry

This is to ensure the certified party is always up to date.

"Certificates of other certification bodies - e.g. ASTQB, ISEB, SAQ and all ISTQB accepted certification bodies - will be recognized as well. Recognition of equivalent certificates is possible (on request). In general equivalent certificates have to be independent of product and producer, internationally accepted, ISO 17024: 2003 compliant."

4 steps to QAMP



1. Requirements Engineering

The first step in system development, Requirements Engineering, is critical for the success of a project.

The IREB® Certified Professional for Requirements Engineering certificate (Foundation Level) confirms that the owner is familiar with terms and definitions of Requirements Engineering and Management as well as that she/he is able to use the basic technologies and methods for Requirements Engineering.

2. Testing

Software systems are omnipresent, human life frequently depends on a frictionless and secure operation of software programs.

The ISTQB® Certified Tester certificate (Foundation Level) confirms that the owner is familiar with the process of planning, specification, operation of software testing and logging of tests.

3. Specified Module

Software Quality Assurance encompasses the entire software development process (software life cycle) which includes processes such as Software Architecture, Test Management, Configuration Management, Project Management or IT-Security Management. The third module focuses on specific problems in software development and can be tailored to the employees' work environment.

- iNTCCM® Certified Professional for Configuration Management
- ASQF® Certified Professional for Project Management
- ASQF® Certified Professional for Internet of Things
- ISSECO® Certified Professional for Secure Software Engineering (maybe replaced with ASQF SSE)

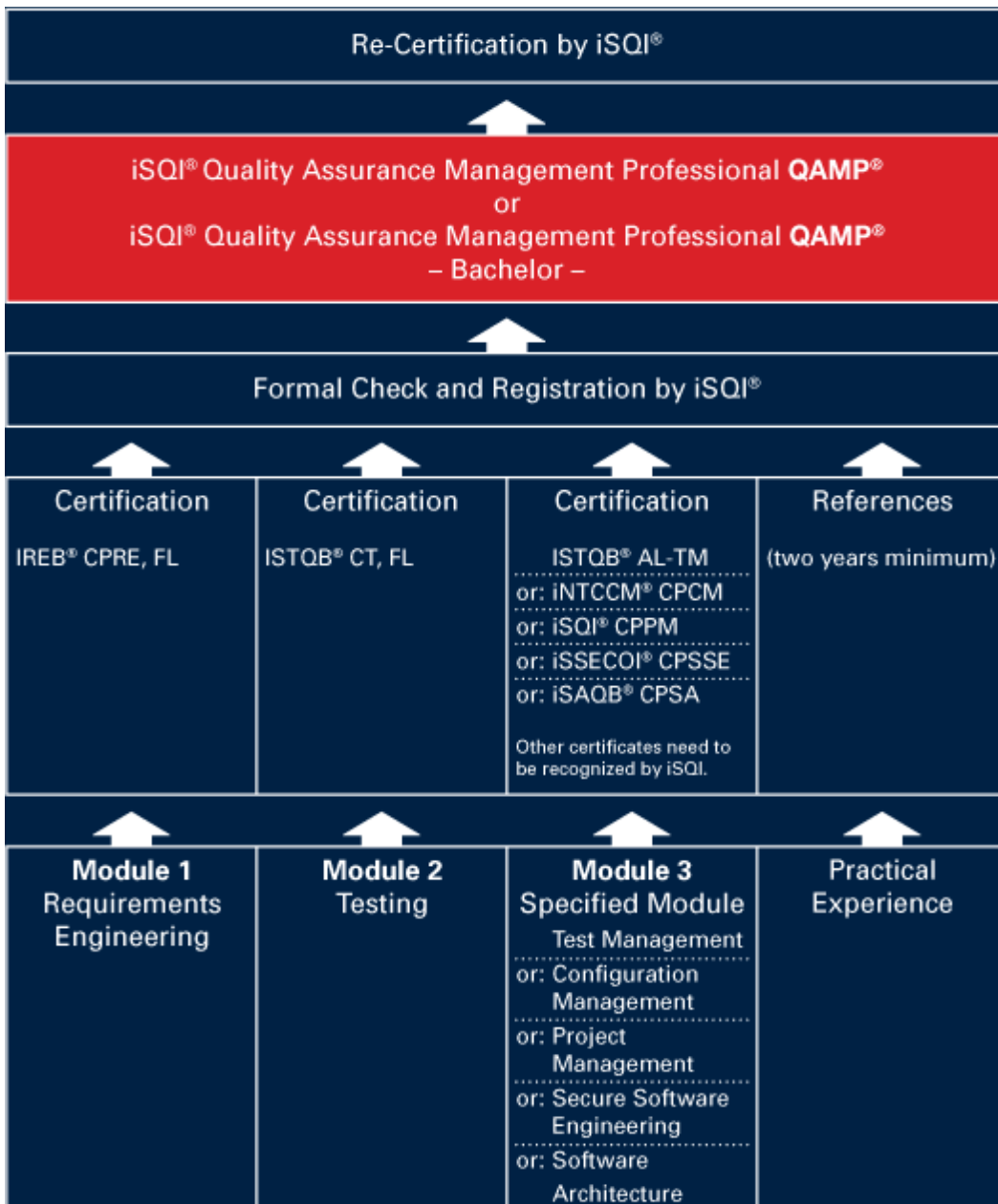

4. Practical experience

Theoretical knowledge is important. Practical experience is equally essential. The owner of the QAMP certificate has at least two years of professional experience in the field of software quality assurance. Experience needs to be updated and demonstrated bi-annually.

(Alternatives: Acquisition of another certificate in the field of software quality assurance management or a lecture given at an international conference, e.g. CONQUEST, SIGIST, STAREAST, STARWEST, Swiss Testing Day, SEETEST, EUROSTAR, Software Quality Days and others in inquiry).

Certification Process:



QAMP qualification program raises the bar!

The QAMP applicant first of all needs to complete the certification in Requirements Engineering, Software-Test and in the discipline of his choice. Upon completion of all 3 certificates, the applicant needs to proof two years of practical experience. Then he or she will be certified as **“iSQI® Quality Assurance Management Professional QAMP.”**

The QAMP® certificate is **valid for 24 month after the date of issue.**

To **extend** the validity for the following **two years** (Re-Certification)

1. practical **work experience** must be demonstrated, or
2. acquisition of **another certificate** in the field of software quality, or
3. a **lecture** given at an international conference, e.g. CONQUEST, EUROSTAR, SEETEST, SiGIST, STAREAST, STARWEST, SQC, SWISS TESTING DAY, TESTING & FINANCE, others on inquiry), recognized by iSQI.

FAQs

- **Who is the QAMP certificate aimed at?**

The QAMP certificate aims at software testers, who need competencies in the entire software development process.

- **How is the QAMP certification structured?**

The QAMP certification has a modular structure: You have to complete three individual standardized training modules and additionally prove that you have project experience.

- **What is the difference between the two compulsory modules and the specified module of choice?**

The compulsory modules require knowledge in the fields of Requirements Engineering (Module 1) and Software-Test (Module 2). The specified module of choice (Module 3) on the other hand comprises the fields of e.g. Software Test Management, Configuration-, Innovation- and Project Management, Secure Software Engineering and Software Architecture. This allows for a tailored training without abandoning the framework of a standardized product- and producer-independent qualification and certification scheme.

- **Is the QAMP certificate internationally recognized?**

For every passed module you will receive an independent certificate. All of those individual certificates are internationally valid and comparable. Their content is developed and monitored by experts in the field of industry, consulting, research and education. One example for such an expert group is the International Software Testing Qualification Board (ISTQB). The ISTQB, founded in 2002 in Edinburgh, is responsible for the international standard for Software-Test: the internationally valid qualification scheme "ISTQB Certified Tester".

At present, for example, around 90,000 candidates in 40 countries hold the ISTQB® Certified Tester Certificate.

- **Do I have to complete the three modules in a set order?**

The different modules can be completed in an arbitrary order; unless the different modules or certification exams are based on each other. A prominent example is the Certified Tester Foundation Level (module 1) and the Certified Tester Advanced Level (if this is your module of choice 3). You could not interchange the order of these two modules.

- **Do I have to pass the modules in a certain time span?**

The modular system makes it possible for participants to begin the training in one location and continue it in another as circumstances dictate, e.g. in case of re-location or due to requirements of client projects. Successful participation in each module will be documented by certification. Completed module certifications are always recognized as valid without time constraints.

- **I have already passed all modules. To whom can I turn to become QAMP?**
